*Professional Members* are also subject to a \$25.00 lapsed fee.

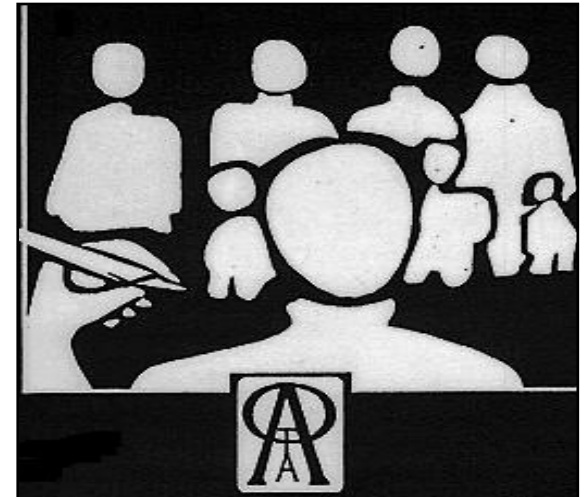
*Graduate and Student Members* are encouraged to maintain annual membership, but are not liable for lapsed membership penalties.
